Mrs. Carol Ann Grinstead Silsby, age 67, passed away on October 8, 2016. A Funeral Service will be held on Tuesday, October 11, 2016 at 11 AM in the Gordon Church of Christ. Interment will follow in Hardie's Chapel Cemetery.

The family will receive friends at Williams White Columns Funeral Home on Monday from 6-8 PM.

Mrs. Silsby was a native of Macon and had lived in Gordon. She had worked as a teacher, Principal of Elementary, and retired as Assistant Superintendent for Wilkinson County Schools.
