Jimmy Wayne Brown, 75, of Cleveland, GA passed away Wednesday, October 13, 2021.

Memorial services for Jimmy Brown will be conducted Sunday, October 17, 2021 at 4 PM in the Chapel Of Williams White Columns Funeral Home of Gordon with the Rev. Dennis Williams officiating. Interment will be private in Ramah Cemetery. The family will receive friends Sunday, October 17, 2021 from 3 PM until the service time.
