Mr. Julian "Red" Carr, 99, of Toombsboro passed away Sunday, November 28, 2021 in South Carolina.

Funeral Services will be conducted Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at 11 AM in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Gordon. Interment will be private in Ebenezer Baptist Church Cemetery. The family will receive friends Tuesday, December 14, 2021 from 10 AM until the service hour.

Mr. "Red" was a life long resident of Wilkinson County, but had moved to his daughter's in South Carolina. He was the Son of the late Alonzo Emmett and Mary Frances Weaver Carr. Mr. "Red" attended Toombsboro High School and was a Veteran of WWII, serving in the Marine Corp. He participated in action at Beuganville, Guam and Iwo Jima.
