



Klonnie Wren Lewis

March 23, 1921 - July 20, 2018

Mrs. Klonnie Wren Lewis, age 97 of Gordon, passed away, Friday, July 20, 2018. Funeral services will be conducted, 2 PM, Sunday, July 22, 2018 in the Gordon First Baptist Church with Rev. Maxie Threatt officiating. The family will receive friends at the Gordon First Baptist Church, following the service. Mrs. Lewis was a native of Glascock County but had made her home in Gordon since 1941. Widow of the late E. Daughter of the late Walter Calhoun Wren, Sr. and Florrie Mae Hadden Wren, she was a former member of the Gordon Woman's Club and Charter member of the Gordon Garden Club. Preceded in death by her brothers: Euell, Allen and Walter Wren, Jr., Mrs. Klonnie was pianist for 61 years in the Gordon First Baptist Church and oldest member of the Gordon First Baptist Church.
