Daughter of the late R. Cecil and Annie Yancey Lord, she was born in the home of her Grandmother, Alma Lord, local artist and was a lifelong resident of Wilkinson County. Preceded in death by her husband, Rev. Ray Tompkins; her son, Steve Tompkins and brothers, Robert, Guyton and Wayne Lord, she attended Toombsboro School, was Valedictorian of her class and graduated from Georgia College with a B.S., Masters and Education Specialist degrees. Ms. Tompkins was a dedicated school teacher for over 20 years and led the school district for 4 ½ years as the first woman Superintendent. She often said "God had given her the opportunity to meet all her goals." She loved and dedicated the early part of her life to her children and grandchildren, offering words of encouragement. The joy of her life was to contribute to many, which she did, serving as pianist for several churches and involving herself in local activities to improve the county and community which included being a member of the Wilco Veterans Association and the Historical Society. Ms. Marlene loved the Lord and was a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church.
