She was a native of Ruby South Carolina and had made her home in Wilkinson County since 1950. She spent 43 years in education working for the Wilkinson County School System as a Teacher/Principal. Mrs. Baxley was the daughter of the late Rev. James and Beulah Rivers Purvis and was preceded in death by her husband Waldo Baxley and son Terry Baxley. She was a 62 year member of Toombsboro Baptist Church.
