



## Shirley Tremon

Funeral services for Mrs. Shirley Ann Butts Tremon will be conducted at 11AM in the Gordon United Methodist Church on Saturday, April 9, 2016 with Rev. Cecile Mitchell officiating. Interment will follow in the Gordon City Cemetery.
