



## Smith "Sam" Dolliver

November 25, 1951 - May 26, 2021

Smith (Sam) Dolliver, Jr., 69, passed away Wednesday, May 26, 2021.

Memorial services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at Martha Bowman United Methodist Church in Macon with Rev. Frank Morris and Rev. Steve Waldorf officiating. Visitation will be at 1:00 p.m.

Son of the late Smith Dolliver, Sr. and the late Helen Means Dolliver of Oklahoma, he was born in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. He grew up in the Presbyterian Church and sang in the choir during his boyhood. He graduated from Roswell High School in 1970. In the summers of his college years, he was a wildfire fighter for the Bureau of Land Management in Idaho. He received a B.S. degree in Forest Resources from the University of Georgia in 1976 and an MBA from Mercer University in 1981. He began work for Georgia Kaolin Company in Dry Branch, Georgia as a Reclamation Forester in 1976 and served in several other capacities for the kaolin industry for 30 years. He was a member of the Xi Sigma Pi forestry honor society, the Society of American Foresters and the Warnell School of Forest Resources Jayhole Club. He enjoyed sporting clays, whitewater canoeing, gardening and traveling in the U.S. Southwest.

Survivors include his wife, Sharon Dolliver; sisters Judy Keller of Edmond, OK and Janet Marshall of Hendersonville, NC; niece Debbie Hines Miller of Midwest City, OK; nephews David Hines (Jennifer) of Edmond, OK, Scott Hines (Angie) of Yukon, OK, and Matthew Marshall (Jennifer) of Candler, NC; and Molly Cat.
