Charles Wayne Brantley, Sr. departed this life to take his heavenly seat with his beloved Ruby on July 2, 2024. At the time of his departure, he was 86 years of age.

Wayne was born in Adrian, Georgia, on January 14, 1938, to Cleo William Brantley and Blanche Smith Brantley. Although residing in Laurens County for the first part of his life, he lived most of his adult life in Wilkinson County, where he farmed and provided for his family by working 38 years at Engelhard, the local kaolin company. During this time, he became a proud and active member of Laurel Branch Church, where he loved singing and worshipping with his family.

Mr. Brantley was preceded in death by his wife, Ruby Mathis Brantley, his parents, and his brother and sister, Beeman (B.C.) Brantley and Mary Scarbrough.
